



Nicholas Holt, AIA, LEED AP is a Co-Founder of Center for Architecture Science and Ecology. Mr. Holt is Director of the Technical Design Group at Skidmore, Owings & Merrill. In this role, he is the responsible for the management of all technical architecture in the New York office.

At one of the world's largest and most prestigious architecture and engineering firms, Mr. Holt oversees 120 architectural staff working on more than 50 projects that total more than seventy-five million square feet in construction valuing nearly forty billion dollars. These projects include three of the ten tallest buildings in the world (Tower One of the World Trade Center, Lotte Tower in Busan, Korea and Digital Media City Landmark Tower in Seoul), entire new campuses in the Middle East and 10 major projects in the New York Area.

Mr. Holt's responsibilities also include all coordination among the various constituencies of each project - the owners, the consultants, the construction teams and the city or public agencies. He also maintains key oversight of SOM NY's sustainability efforts, including management of the new Center for Architecture Science and Ecology, and continually works on researching and testing advanced integrated project delivery systems and Building Information Modeling software. Mr. Holt received a Bachelor of Architecture from Auburn University. He is a registered Architect in New York State.
